Job Description:

We have an immediate opening for an Insulation Installer/Weatherization Technician. The Technician will be responsible insulating and weatherizing existing homes to improve energy efficiency. The position is full-time with a competitive salary and benefits. Experience in residential weatherization is strongly preferred.

Primary duties include installing insulation, both loose-fill or dense-pack cellulose using blowing machines, and fiber batting; air sealing the building envelope; prep work; and diagnostic testing using a blower door and health & safety tools. All work is performed according to written work orders and industry protocols.

Daily responsibilities will also include checking schedules, loading/unloading trucks, equipment maintenance, travel to the jobsite, job tracking and reporting, client relations and quality checking.

- Experience in residential weatherization is strongly preferred
- Experience with blown insulation in existing structures, residential construction, and/or residential carpentry; BPI and other industry certifications are all pluses.
